

CHECK IF YOUR LICENSE EXPIRES IN 2021

If you need to renew by July 31, 2021, use this helpful checklist to ensure you earn the correct CPE before June 30, 2021, to avoid penalties.

TIME TO CHECK IF YOU'RE ON TRACK:

- Have you earned or carried over 80 hours of CPE between July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021?
- Were 40 hours of CPE earned in the July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020 earning period?
Reminder: Due to COVID-19, LARA lifted the 50% cap on self-study for CPE earned between April 2, 2020 – June 30, 2020
- Have you earned 40 hours of CPE between July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021?
Reminder: Only 50% of your annual requirement can be earned through self-study programs
- Do you have 8 hours of Accounting and Auditing (A&A) in each year, for a total of 16 hours?
- Do you have a total of 2 hours of Ethics, in each year, for a total of 4 hours?
- Is one of your 4 Ethics hours - Michigan Specific Ethics 2019-21 Edition?
- If you are carrying over hours, is the total under the 40-hour maximum with no more than 8 hours for A&A and 2 hours of Ethics?
