Advocacy in Action: In the past year, PAC contributions helped make progress on:

- **Uniform Accountancy Act Updates for CPA Licensure** – AICPA and NASBA introduced an additional pathway to licensure (bachelor’s degree + two years of experience + CPA Exam) and an interstate mobility model based on feedback from the MICPA, other state societies and all of our members.
- **Michigan Flow-Through Entity Tax Bill (HB 5022)** – MICPA, its members, and Michigan Treasury worked together to provide input, testimony and support for this bill which passed early in 2025 and addresses implementation challenges from earlier legislation.
- **CPA Day at the Capitol** – In 2025, MICPA organized its second CPA Day in Lansing, bringing 70+ members and students together to discuss profession-related issues with their legislators.

These wins are a direct result of your contributions. Without PAC investments, CPAs would have less influence in shaping these outcomes. Every name on this list represents a commitment to the future of the CPA profession.
